### **Championship Event Payout**

Based on 15 Teams for 14 events Estimated Max. \$130 Admin. Costs 1<sup>st</sup> Place 60% \$678\*& Plaques 2<sup>nd</sup> Place 30% \$339 3<sup>rd</sup> Place 10% \$113

\*If only 2 teams score fish, 60% will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 40% to 2<sup>nd</sup>. If only 1 team scores fish, they will receive 100% of prize money. If no fish are caught, prize money will be equally divided among all Championship participants. Big bass will break ties for each place they occur.

First come, first served, <u>we won't take</u> <u>entries past 19 boats</u>, don't ask and show up earlier next week!

# Rules for 2020 Season <u>Registration and Take Off</u>

Registration will take place weekly between 5:00p-5:45pm. Entry fee is \$15 per person, per event. Up to three take off positions will be reserved for volunteer release boats on a first come first serve basis. A team may not volunteer two consecutive weeks unless no other teams are interested. All tournaments will be limited to 19 boats, first come, first served! No reservations or prepays for other participants accepted. If there is a shortage of release boats, the Tournament Director will volunteer or assign as needed. All non-release boats will be assigned by draw the day of the tournament.

Boats must have working live wells. Last boat out will check live wells. **Tournament Director may delay take off or cancel any event (including the Championship) due to weather conditions. Take off locations cannot change.** All participants must sign a Don's Marine liability waiver prior to their first event.

## <u>Weigh In</u>

Teams must be inside nearest launch site "Slow No Wake" buoy by Tournament Hours end time. *Late is late and fish will not be scored!* One largemouth or smallmouth bass may be scored per angler. Fish will be measured to the nearest 1/8" with tail fanned to longest position. Dead fish (or almost) will not be scored, **no questions asked**. Short fish will result in both angler and team disqualification for the night.

### <u>Standings</u> TEAMS

A participating boat must pay \$30 per event to be scored as a **Team**. A **Team** member may pay double entry <u>and fish</u> <u>alone</u> and score 2 fish. A **Team may use a substitute partner for a maximum of 3 of the 14 events.** After a Team uses their 3<sup>rd</sup> substitution during the season, the only way to score 2 fish for Team standings is for 1 of the original Team members to fish alone and pay double entry. If a Team member fishes alone and does not pay a double entry fee, their catch will not be scored toward Team length, but will count toward AOY for that event.

Only **Team** members or substitutes are allowed in the boat during each event. *Only 2 anglers will be allowed in a boat to be scored as a Team.*

# <u>Scoring</u>

### Angler of the Year(AOY)

AOY will be determined by greatest individual total length at the end of the season. Big bass breaks tie.

### **Team Standings**

Team standings will be based on total length for all Team qualifying events as outlined under Standings. Big bass breaks tie.

## Tournament Water Limits

West-RR Bridge to Sauk Dam East- RR Bridge to 33 Bridge Portage

## **Championship** Event

Up to 10 **Team** boats could earn a spot to fish in the Championship tournament. To qualify for the Championship you must: -Finish in the top 10 **Team** total length standings after the August 6<sup>th</sup> event. (Big Bass Breaks Tie) <u>AND!!!!!</u>

-Fish as a **Team** in at least 11 of the 14 regular season events. Some participation exceptions may be made for anglers having <u>serious</u> medical conditions or surgery.

# Sportsmanship and Safety

All local and state boating regulations apply. <u>There will be zero tolerance for</u> <u>unsportsmanlike conduct at an event</u> <u>or being late to weigh in.</u> Live bait or trolling is not allowed. "Stocking" or moving fish is not allowed. One rod in water per angler. Tournament Director reserves the right to disqualify participants for unsportsmanlike conduct toward anyone on the water or at the landing for an event or the season. All complaints will be reviewed by a Tournament Director. Life jackets must be worn when big motor is running, or DQ'd!
